## Survival School Set At Medford

How to survive in the wilderness is the subject matter for an unusual school to be conducted at Medford this summer.

Six 10-day sessions are planned between June 10 and Aug. 19. Purpose of the school is to teach techniques and knowledge that will make all wilderness activities safer and more enjoyable, the school directors state.

During each session, three days will be devoted to academic instruction. This will involve lectures, films, slides and actual field demonstrations. Each day of instruction will be spent, at least in part, in woodland and mountain areas near Medford.

Curriculum will cover such topics as shelter construction, primitive cooking, improvised fishing techniques, edible plants and animals, wilderness raft construction and emergency signal devices.

Then the class goes on a seven-day field training safari into the Trinity Alps Wilderness Area of Northern California. No food will be taken along, the idea being that the students will live off the land.

Participants must be in good physical condition. It is required that students be at least 14 years old (father and son teams are encouraged) and have no less than two years of camping experience.

Cost of the session is \$115. Reservations are made by writing to the Wilderness Survival School, Box 1181, Medford.

The school directors are Odd Bjerke, a leader in the U.S. Geographical Expedition to the Greenland Ice Cap; Robert Huff, a high school teacher, wilderness enthusiast and conservation expert; and Gary Beard, Rogue River Valley cattle rancher, expert horseman and active outdoorsman.

The directors point out that every year hundreds of people get lost in forests and mountains. It is the directors' belief that if more knowledge of the art of wilderness survival was known by the individuals who travel the wilderness trails, many lives could be saved.

## Alert Students Avert Tragedy

DELAKE, Ore. (UPI) — Alert students helped avert a tragedy here Wednesday afternoon when three Silverton High School seniors were struck by a large wave in the surf.

Vicki Reed, 17, was given artificial respiration after swallowing sea water and later was reported in fair condition.

A human chain formed by other students helped in the rescue after one of them, Mike Jarvel, had gone to the girl's aid.

The girl and Hank Shenk and Skip Adams, both 18, went into the surf. Jarvel and other students on the beach saw the big breaker strike them. The girl cried out and disappeared.

Jarvel rushed in and grabbed the girl. Other students, with the aid of a rope obtained from a concessionaire, formed a human chain.

All four were brought safely to shore. The girl was given artificial respiration by the Devils Lake Fire Department.

About 120 Silverton High School seniors had gone to the coast for an outing.

## Everest Climber Visited By Wife

KATMANDU, Nepal (UPI) — The wife of Barry Bishop, a member of the American expedition attempting an unprecedented double assault on Mt. Everest, returned to Katmandu today after climbing part way up the mountain to visit her husband.

Mrs. Lila Bishop hiked for three weeks to see her husband at the 17,000-foot base camp on the slopes of Mt. Everest.

Bishop, 30, a photographer for the National Geographic Society in Washington, D.C., was high up the mountain today at advance Camp 2 at 21,300 feet in a new assault on the 29,028-foot peak. He and Luther G. Jerstad, 26, Eugene, Ore., reached the camp Tuesday in an attempt to scale Mt. Everest through the south col (pass).

James W. Whittaker used this route May 1 when he became the first American to conquer the peak, highest in the world.

On the unexplored west ridge, nine Nepalese Sherpa guides labored today under the leadership of expedition member William Unsoeld, 36, Corvallis, Ore., bringing loads to Camp 4 at 23,100 feet.

The two teams hope to meet on the summit by next Tuesday and come down together through the south col. It was the first time such an exploit had even been attempted.

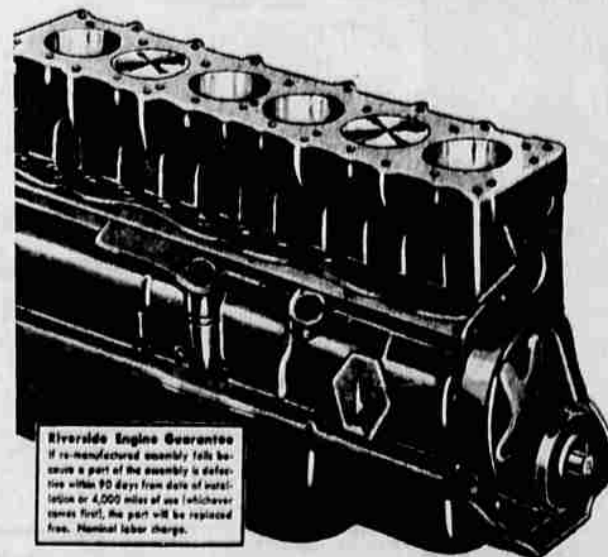
