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Ethiopia Gets Glide Books

The Glide High School chapter of the National Honor Society is currently engaged in sending books to Peace Corps volunteers in Ethiopia, particularly Gene Rosaschi and Jerry Lemert, both former instructors at Glide High School.

Funds for this project are coming from the treasury of the now-defunct Project 35 (Trip to Mexico), of which Rosaschi was once advisor. In January a cabinet meeting was held to decide what to do with the \$50 balance reported still remaining in the treasury. It was decided to use the money to forward desperately needed books to students of Lemert and Rosaschi in Dessie, Ethiopia.

Since then, several inquiries have been made by the Honor Society into the availability of low cost shipment for the books. A final decision to use ordinary mail channels has been reached and the first package was sent May 9.
