

Roseburg's 'Sister' Being Picked From Latin America

The Roseburg Sister City Committee Wednesday picked Latin America as the area from which to select its sister city.

The selection was narrowed down to Mexico, Chile, Brazil, Uruguay and Argentina.

The committee voted to hold a special meeting with representatives of the city's news media next Wednesday noon to discuss plans for a campaign to encourage residents of the city to help determine which of the five countries will be named from which to seek a sister city.

Detailed information on the countries, and later on the individual cities within the country selected,

will be obtained from the American Municipal Association.

Mrs. Sid (Betty) Domenico, 211 W. Berdine, presented a special report on background study into the Latin American nations. All of the five nations on the selection list are Spanish-speaking countries, with the exception of Brazil, in which Portuguese is the prime language.

All are basically governed on democratic principals and all are predominately Catholic in religion.

Facts Presented

Mrs. Domenico presented these facts on the five nations under consideration:

MEXICO — Excels in literature

and the arts. The middle class of people is being expanded. There are still, however, many hundreds of thousands of the very poor. In general, Mexico is a land of contrasts, with extremely rich and extremely poor citizens, ultra-modern buildings and ancient Maya Indian ruins.

CHILE — Is a strongly democratic country. Chile has much poverty, but excels in primary and secondary education and has recently increased its enrollment.

ARGENTINA — Is a rich land capable of large increases in production. Its people are literate and competent in business, farming, industry, the arts and education.

BRAZIL — Perhaps the most interesting and in some ways similar to the United States. It is a very large and diverse nation, which is traditionally a friend of the United States.

URUGUAY — Is definitely white European in origin and has always been true to the democratic tradition. Has a growing middle class, and like the others, a free press. Has a strongly-developing university life, and less than 20

per cent illiteracy. Has made notable records in industrialization.

Chairman Pete Serafin said the committee hopes to be ready to name its sister city this fall. The Latin American countries were chosen, among other reasons, because so many students in the local schools are studying Spanish, and because many of these countries have English as a required school subject.
