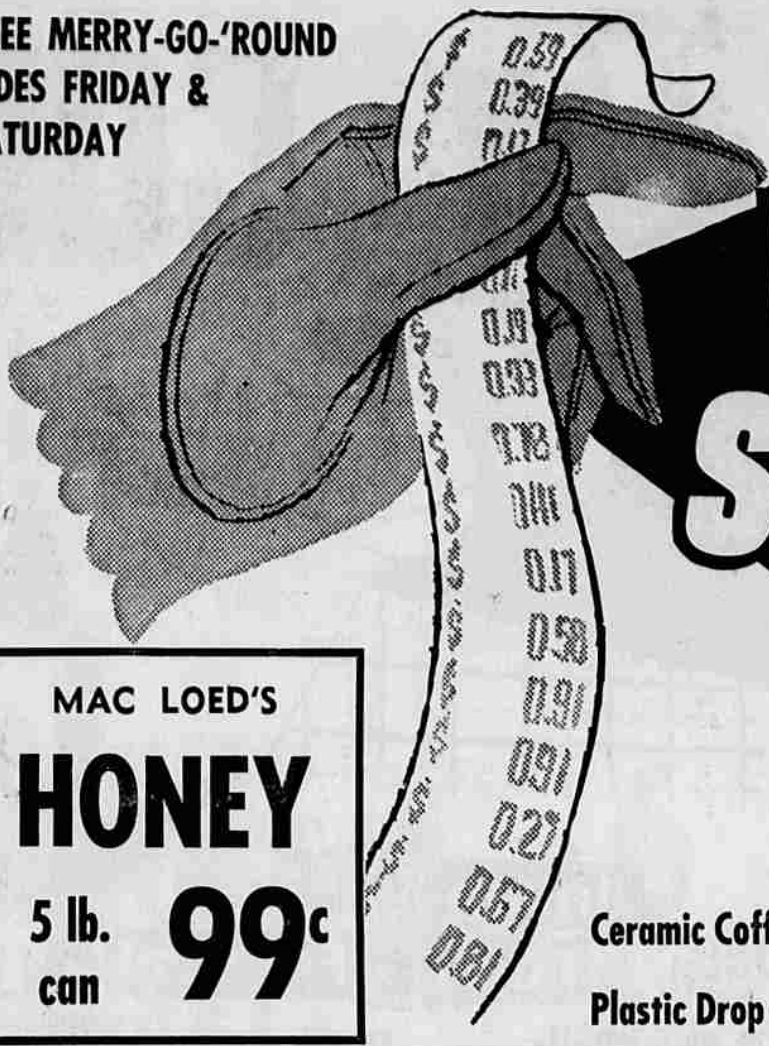

New Salad Recipe Has Butter Flavor In Tasty Dressing

The outdoor eating season is in full swing, and a new salad recipe is always welcome. Good cooks who love the flavor of real butter in their cooking, as well as the baked potato and "gobs of butter" crowd will be pleased with this new-style Buttered Potato Salad with its golden color and intriguing flavor.

Diced cooked potatoes are combined with chopped green onion, celery, and hard-cooked egg. Then to give the salad its zesty flavor, mix together this special dressing with vinegar, sugar, dry mustard and melted butter. The butter takes the place of salad oil or bacon fat. You'll want to take care to mix the dressing and add it to the salad at the last minute before serving. But do not refrigerate the salad once the butter dressing has been added, since the butter will solidify.

If you'd like to save time, you can mix the potatoes, celery, onion and egg and refrigerate that combination, adding the dressing at serving time.

Your family will rave about this appetizing golden salad topped with circles of hard-cooked egg. With its tasty new dressing, it's an ideal carry-along salad for picnics, cook-outs for back yard meals. Enjoy Buttered Potato Salad with cold meats, crisp relishes and tall glasses of cold milk.

Buttered Potato Salad
6-8 servings
4 cups diced, cooked potatoes
1/4 cup chopped green onion
1/2 cup finely chopped celery
3 hard cooked eggs, chopped
1 teaspoon dry mustard
1 tablespoon sugar
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 cup vinegar
1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, melted
Hard-cooked eggs, sliced
garnish

In a bowl combine potatoes, onion, celery and eggs; toss gently. In a small bowl combine mustard, sugar, salt and vinegar; stir until dissolves. Stir in butter. Just before serving, toss butter dressing with potatoes; garnish with egg.

Complaint
First National Bank of Oregon, Portland, vs. William P. Scallon, administrator of the estate of John J. Grabow deceased; Camille S. Sullivan, also known as Camille S. Grabow; Barbara H. Grabow; Barbara McIntyre aka Barbara B. McIntyre; Judy Ann Metropoulos, formerly Judith Grabow; Susan J. Rae, formerly Susan Grabow; John J. Grabow; V. Michael Grabow, also known as Michael Lester Grabow, individually and as representatives of their issue now in being and as yet unborn. Plaintiff asks decree of the court determining the rightful disposition of the trust corpus and proceeds therefrom, now held and to be acquired by plaintiff under terms of said trust agreement by declaring the rights and legal relations of all parties listed in respect to the trust agreement. The plaintiff, as trustee, asserts it now holds the approximate sum of \$90,333.64 in trust set up by John J. Grabow, now deceased, on April 9, 1959. Grabow died Sept. 11, 1962, and Scallon was named administrator. Until Sept. 6, Barbara H. Grabow was the wife of John J. Grabow, on which date marriage was dissolved by decree of the court. The decree of divorce purports to award to her \$6,500 in lieu of any other share in the life insurance proceeds which form the trust corpus now held by the plaintiff. The complaint states that on Aug. 23, 1962, Camille S. Sullivan, also known as Camille S. Grabow, joined with John J. Grabow, in a marriage ceremony in Reno, Nev. The plaintiff alleges that the claims of defendants conflict and there are not sufficient funds to pay all the claims of defendants.

Peter B. Serafin and Joseph W. Dent, co-partners dba Roseburg Realty & Insurance Co., vs. G. R. Emery. Plaintiffs ask judgment for \$2,100 plus attorney fees alleged due as commission for property sold by plaintiffs for defendant.

Dismissal
State of Oregon, by its State Highway Commission, vs. Mary Ruth Moran. On motion of plaintiff, case dismissed without prejudice.
