

CIRCUIT COURT

Complaints
Kenneth Hong vs. The City of Sutherlin and Evan and Barbara Sifton. Plaintiff asks for decree of court allowing them to pay to defendants Sifton the sums of \$16.04, \$1.76 and \$130.36 and declaring the plaintiff's title to property described to be free and clear from any claim or lien from the city of Sutherlin accruing prior to the date of sale of the property to the Siftons. He asks further that the Siftons have no right, title or interest in the premises and that the title of plaintiff is quieted as against the defendants. Plaintiff alleges that the city of Sutherlin took the property, listed as Lots 7 and 8, Block 15, Plat O, Sutherlin Land and Water Co., in a foreclosure of sewer assessment, and later sold the property to the Siftons for \$160.41. This sum, together with a penalty of \$16.04 and interest of \$1.76 is now tendered into court by the plaintiff. The plaintiff alleges he could not be served by the sewer because an easement through property lying directly to the south of his real property was not secured by the city.

L. E. Henninger vs. LeRoy A. McCracken. Plaintiff demands judgment for \$1,400 plus interest allegedly owing and due on 10 k bunk truck and two drum donkey with winch and engine purchased Sept. 19, 1958.

Robert R. and June A. Nicholson vs. Otto and Emma E. Nitschke. Suit to foreclose on contract for sale of property listed as the easterly four feet of Lot 3 and all of Lots 1 and 2, Block 51, Kinney's improved plat to the city of Roseburg. Plaintiffs allege principal sum of \$6,974.38 owing and due.

Clyde Poole vs. State Industrial Accident Commission. Plaintiff asks re-opening of case and allowance to him of permanent partial disability equal to 100 per cent loss function of an arm for unscheduled disability and 35 per cent loss function of plaintiff's left leg, for injuries allegedly suffered by plaintiff June 15, 1961, while employed by Sawdust Service. He alleges he suffered head, neck and leg injuries in an automobile accident in the course of his employment.

Richard L. and Josephine Carr vs. Smith Wood Products Inc., a Missouri Corp. not presently licensed to do business in Oregon, and other named defendants. Suit to quiet title to property located in Township 25, South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian.

Dismissal
Theron Johnston vs. L. O. Grimes, Gerald H. Ross and Charles Ross.

Harold Cole, et al. vs. Forrest Solomon, et al. On motion of plaintiffs, case dismissed with prejudice and without costs.

Douglas W. Parazoo vs. Forrest Solomon, et al. On motion of plaintiff case dismissed with prejudice and without costs.

Douglas W. Parazoo and Chester E. Cline vs. Armstrong Timber Co., Inc. On motion of plaintiffs, case dismissed with prejudice and without costs.

Harold Cole vs. Armstrong Timber Co. On motion of plaintiff, case dismissed with prejudice and without costs.

Decree
Van Woodward, executor of the estate of Helen A. Woodward, vs. Allan K. and Betty J. Kytola. Judgment granted plaintiff for \$8,979.58, plus interest and attorney fees, with decree of foreclosure on real property located on Camas Creek at Wilbur.

Order
Virginia A. vs. Jack R. Barnett. Defendant ordered to pay to plaintiff \$150 for attorney fees and \$35 for court costs, at the rate of \$30.83 monthly in a divorce proceeding.

State of Oregon, ex rel. Joan O. Johnson, formerly Joan O. Snodgrass, vs. Truman Snodgrass. Defendant ordered to appear in court June 17 to show cause why he should not be found guilty of contempt of court for violating the decree of Court dated Oct. 5, 1959, for failure to pay child support and attorney fees.

Julia M. vs. William J. Cantwell. Order of the court restrains defendant from molesting or bothering plaintiff or her minor son pending divorce suit. Show cause order issued for defendant to appear June 10 on child support of \$75 monthly, alimony of \$50 monthly for plaintiff and attorney fees and court costs.

State of Oregon, ex rel. Maxine Mattox, formerly Maxine Thompson, vs. Darwin D. Thompson. Court orders defendant to appear June 17 and show cause why he should not be held in contempt of court for failure to comply with court order on child support. Plaintiff alleges defendant is \$1,521.50 in arrears on child support.

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
