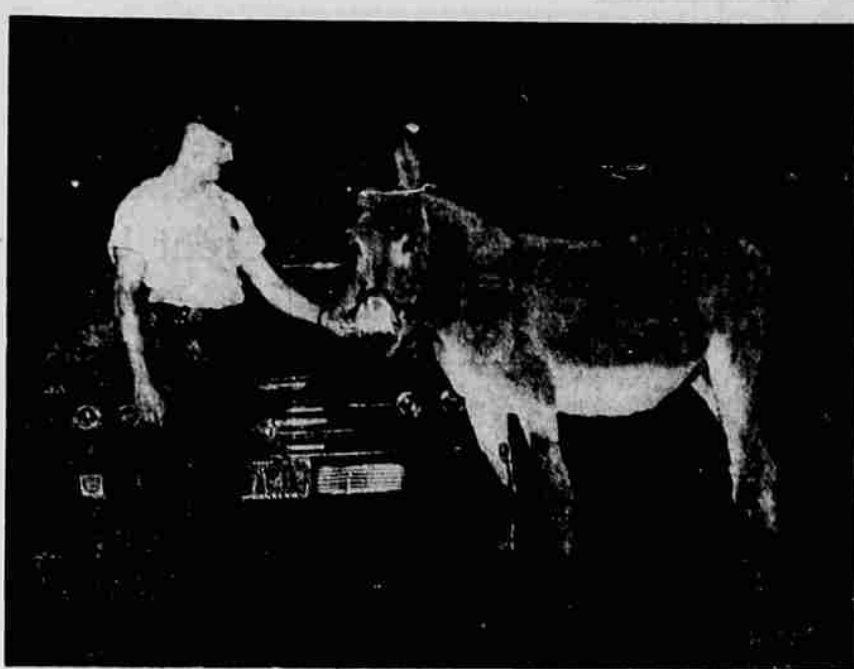

Notice is hereby given, that at the regular meeting of the Board of Directors of Winston-Harrison Rural Fire Protection District of Douglas County, Oregon, held May 5, 1963, a special election has been called to be held at the Winston-Harrison Fire Hall (Station) on Monday, June 17, 1963, between the hours of 2 o'clock p.m. and 8 o'clock p.m., Pacific Daylight Time, and there will be submitted to the legal voters of said District the question of levying a tax in the amount of \$4,400.00 outside the limitations imposed by Article XI, Section 11, Oregon Constitution, for the purpose of defraying additional costs of fire protection and suppression service of the District including, but not limited to, the hiring of additional personnel.

The vote upon the levy of said tax in said sum of \$4,400.00 outside the limitation imposed by the Oregon Constitution as above said shall be by ballot upon which shall be the words:

**EXCEED THE 4% LIMITATION ( ) YES**

**AND EXCEED THE 4% LIMITATION ( ) NO**

and the voter shall place a cross (X) between the words "Exceed the 4% Limitation" and the word "Yes", or between the words "Exceed the 4% Limitation" and the word "No", whichever indicates his choice.

The polls for the reception of ballots cast for or against the above mentioned proposition will be open said day and date and at the place aforesaid be opened at 2 o'clock p.m. and remain open until 8 o'clock p.m. of said day, all Pacific Daylight Time, at which latter hour the same shall be closed.

**ELEANOR P. NYE, EDITH BRATSCH,** and **COURTNEY NELSON** have been selected and appointed as judges of said election and shall constitute the election board of said District for said election.
