ADMINISTRATIVE USE UNDER REGULATION 5-24

Three-Elk Salvage Sale

Oral auction bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor, or his authorized representative at the office of the Forest Supervisor, Federal Office Building, Roseburg, Oregon, beginning at 2:00 P.M. July 9, 1963, for all merchantable timber marked or designated for cutting on an area embracing 437 acres, more or less, within sections 25, 26, 27, 28, 33, 34 and 35, T. 27 S., R. 2 E., and sections 29, 30 and 32, T. 27 S., R. 2 E., W.M. surveyed in the Umpqua National Forest, Oregon. The estimated volumes are: 490 M board feet of Douglas-fir and pine, 640 M board feet of Shasta red fir and noble fir, 360 M board feet of white fir and other species. The minimum acceptable bid per M board feet is as follows: Douglas-fir and pine \$22.80, Shasta red fir and noble fir \$10.45, white fir and other species \$9.40. This includes the following rates, per M board feet for stumpage including deposit for sale area betterment: \$3.00 base rate plus an additional \$1.50 for Douglas-fir and pine, \$2.00 base rate plus an additional \$1.50 for Shasta red fir and noble fir, \$2.00 base rate plus an additional \$1.50 for white fir and other species and \$2.30 for slash disposal for all species. The prices bid for stumpage shall be considered as tentative rates subject to quarterly readjustment upward or downward by 0.5 of the difference between the average of the monthly Douglas-fir region indices, as calculated by the Forest Service for the three previous months, and the following base indices: Douglas-fir and pine 103.02(C), Shasta red fir and noble fir 103.02(C), white fir and other species 91.68(A). Such adjustments in the price for stumpage shall be applicable to timber scaled during the three-month period following the quarter for which the adjustment is computed. In no event, however, shall the payment rates for each quarter be less than the base rates as stated above. When the adjusted rates by species are lower than the base rates, the difference between the total dollar value of the timber cut at adjusted rates and at base rates will be recorded for each species. The stumpage rate for a species will not be increased above the base rate until the subsequent adjusted rates above the base rate will develop an accumulated total dollar value for the species in excess of the recorded accumulated difference for all species. If the contract period is extended, the Forest Service shall readjust the rates for stumpage and required deposits as of and effective on the day following the original termination date, but readjusted rates for each species product shall be no lower than the rate effective immediately prior to the effective date of the extension plus the following increases in stumpage rates: Douglas-fir and pine \$1.73, Shasta red fir and noble fir \$1.67, white fir and other species \$1.41. Sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted, at the office of the Forest Supervisor, at 2:00 P.M., on July 9, 1963. All the who submitted a satisfactory sealed bid will be permitted immediately to continue auction bidding. A money order, bank draft, cashier's or certified check in the sum of \$5,400.00 must accompany each bid, to be applied to the purchase price, refunded, or retained for application to any claim for damages according to the conditions of sale. If requested by the purchaser, contract terms will permit felling of timber in advance of payment up to the value of the performance bond. If an oral bid is declared to be high at the closing of the auction, the bidder must immediately confirm the bid by submitting it in writing on a Forest Service bid form. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Forest Service bid forms for use in submitting sealed bids and full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale and the submission of bids should be obtained from the District Ranger, South Umpqua Ranger District, Tiller, Oregon, or the Forest Supervisor, Roseburg, Oregon, before bids are submitted.
