

Distraught Mother Claims She Threw Child Off Bridge

SAN MATEO, Calif. (UPI)—Police today investigated the chilling case of a San Carlos, Calif., mother who said she threw the body of her 2-year-old daughter off the Golden Gate Bridge.

The mother, Anna Buckleman, 36, underwent psychiatric examination Thursday at San Mateo General Hospital. She was held under what a hospital spokesman called "security guard" to prevent a possible new suicide attempt.

Mrs. Buckleman said the child fell down the cellar stairs 10 days ago.

Early the next morning, while her husband slept, she found her child dead in bed, she told authorities. She drove to the bridge, threw the tiny pajama-clad body over the side but then could not get up the nerve to jump herself, she said.

Instead, she fled to New York where she attempted to kill herself with an overdose of sleeping pills.

The Coast Guard said no trace of the child's body has been found under the bridge. An infant's body found in New York City was not that of the Buckleman girl, according to police.

Capt. Edwin Mailliard of the San Carlos police department said "we are trying to gather the evidence to prove or disprove her story. I'll meet with members of the staff of district attorney Keith Sorenson and we will put it all together—including the doctor's reports on Mrs. Buckleman. Then we'll decide what action to take, if any."

Mrs. Ted Kennedy Undergoes Surgery

HYANNIS, Mass. (UPI)—Mrs. Joan Kennedy, wife of Sen. Edward M. Kennedy, D-Mass., had a sore throat today but otherwise was in good condition following surgery for an abscess.

She was reported "resting comfortably" at Cape Cod Hospital, through suffering from a sore throat, the after-effect of the surgery.

The 30-minute operation on her throat was performed Thursday by Dr. Frank Lathrop, chief of the eye, ear, nose and throat section of Boston's famed Lahey Clinic, assisted by Dr. Robert C. Watt of Hyannis.

It was expected that the 26-year-old mother of two, who suffered a miscarriage May 16, would be confined to the hospital for about three days.

Authorities said the surgery was for relief of a parotid abscess. They emphasized that the ailment was not connected with the miscarriage.

Mrs. Kennedy was admitted to the hospital Tuesday from her summer home at Squaw Island, Hyannis Port. She was visited by her husband and his sister, Mrs. Eunice Shriver, before undergoing the operation.

Mrs. Kennedy's illness forced cancellation of her husband's extensive Fourth of July speaking schedule. A spokesman for the senator said Kennedy had to return to Washington next week but that he might delay his return if she were not out of the hospital by that time.

SNOW ON FOURTH
