Expense Drop Buoy's Chance For Tax Cut

WASHINGTON (UPI)—A sharp cut in government red-ink spending today buoyed prospects for House approval of the income tax cut President Kennedy wants.

Kennedy announced the good news Wednesday. He told a televised news conference that the government wound up the fiscal year on June 30 with a budget deficit \$2.6 billion less than he had predicted last January.

The President said final figures to be released by the Treasury within the next few days would show that outgo exceeded income by only \$8.2 billion. In his January budget message Kennedy had forecast an \$8.8 billion deficit.

He noted, happily, that the deficit had turned out to be even smaller than the previous fiscal year. The deficit for the year which ended June 30, 1962 — the first full fiscal year of the Kennedy administration — was \$6.4 billion.

Kennedy coupled the announcement with a renewed plea for passage this year of a \$10 billion cut in income taxes for individuals and corporations.

Other congressional news: TFX — Navy Secretary Fred Korth appears for the seventh time in the continuing congressional investigation into the controversial TFX fighter plane contract award. Chairman John L. McClellan, D-Ark., of the Senate investigations subcommittee so far has held four months of hearings into the award of the \$5.5 billion contract to General Dynamics Corp. over Boeing Co.

Nature May Spoil Its Own Big Show

BAR HARBOR, Maine (UPI)—Nature could spoil nature's big show Saturday, at least for spectators on the ground.

The weather was topmost in the minds of scientists gathering here to observe the total eclipse of the sun.

The weather bureau forecast a light cover of puffy cumulus clouds over central Maine, the only area in the United States except Alaska where the eclipse may be seen in its entirety.

A forecaster said the chances are better than 50-50 that the total eclipse will be seen by most persons except in spots where clouds obscure nature's most awesome performance.

Though the forecast generally is favorable, New England is widely known for its whimsical weather.

If the weather cooperates, the eclipse will be viewed by about 100,000 persons including scientists on the ground and in jet aircraft traveling nearly twice the speed of sound at altitudes up to 48,000 feet. The jets aircraft will be able to fly above normal cloud covers.

Scientists believe that fish and wildlife may put on some show of their own when the moon moves between the earth and the sun, causing a sudden darkness to fall over the area.

The Committee on Oceanography of the National Academy of Science wants to know in particular what herring will do during the period of darkness. The fish and wildlife service has been asked to watch all types of fish and land animals to see what happens.

At the same time, the American Medical Association has issued stern warnings that the human eye can be damaged severely if exposed, even briefly, to the direct rays of the sun.

Doctors warned that the only safe method of watching an eclipse is by the "projection method," that is, by looking at an image of it on a piece of paper while facing away from the sun.

Ambulance Patient Dies After Crash With Bus

PORTLAND (UPI) — Gabriel Schmidt, 78, Portland, died in a hospital here Wednesday after an ambulance in which he was riding collided with a Greyhound bus and a pickup truck.

Schmidt suffered a heart attack Tuesday and was being taken to the hospital. He was not injured, but was reported in poor condition on arrival. He died a short time later.

Police said the ambulance entered an intersection against a red light with its siren blowing. Drivers of both the bus and the pickup said they were unable to stop in time to avoid the collision.

RETRACTS OFFER

CANNINGHAM, England (UPI) — Last Sunday Anglican Vicar Arthur Moss told his parishioners to go right ahead and interrupt his sermon if they had any objections to make.

Responding spiritedly to the invitation, the congregation filled the church with protest.

Today, after giving the matter thoughtful consideration, the Rev. Mr. Moss said he would insist on at least seven minutes of uninterrupted sermon next Sunday.

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
