

Brooks Man Held On Wetback Count

PHOENIX, Ariz. (UPI) — An Oregon man was held without bond here pending arrival of charges that he illegally brought Mexicans into the U.S. as farm laborers.

Immigration authorities arrested Joe Frank Langston, 23, of Brooks, Ore., Tuesday. He appeared before U.S. Commissioner N. B. Wilson, but a hearing was postponed until formal charges arrive.

Federal authorities said Langston and Marion Kenneth Wilson, 58, of Portland, Ore., were suspected of enticing some 50 Mexican farm workers to enter the country to take jobs picking cherries in Oregon. Authorities said Wilson was arrested and arraigned Monday in Deming, N.M., and is held on \$1,000 bond.

The workers were sent back to Mexico after being questioned in Deming.

Complaints

Robert C. Cooper vs. State Industrial Accident Commission. Plaintiff seeks additional compensation for temporary total disability until his condition becomes stationary, and further medical aid and treatment, and thereafter compensation for permanent partial disability equal to 100 per cent loss of use and function of an arm for unscheduled disability, or in such other sums and amounts as his condition shall warrant, plus costs and disbursements. Plaintiff's claim stems from injuries received in a fall at a wood plant on Oct. 2, 1961.

Jeannette F. Lewis vs. Joan Rosalie Edwards. Plaintiff asks a award of \$25,000 as general damages, \$406.90 for medical expenses incurred to date and \$1,685 for lost earnings and wages to date, plus costs and disbursements. Plaintiff alleges defendant was careless and negligent in connection with a traffic accident Aug. 12, 1962, on Highway 38 about 24 miles east of Reedsport and in which vehicles operated by plaintiff and defendant were involved. According to the complaint, plaintiff was traveling south on Highway 38 at a point where the highway makes easterly turn, and as the plaintiff was approaching a curve to her left, plaintiff met an oncoming vehicle and trailer. Plaintiff alleges defendant was driving her car north and attempted to pass the auto and trailer and occupied the lane of traffic for east-bound vehicles. Complaint states plaintiff drove her car onto the south shoulder of the highway where the two vehicles collided, causing plaintiff to suffer severe injuries.

David H. Cameron, Department of Employment Commissioner, vs. John C. Kubli. Plaintiff asks judgment against defendant for \$183, as an alleged overpayment because of misrepresentation and nondisclosure of facts.

J. A. Gendron & Co., Inc., vs. R. H. Gee, dba R. H. Gee Engineering Service. Plaintiff demands judgment for \$1,475.39 plus interest alleged due on a judgment made in the Eighth Judicial District Court of Montana Jan. 3, 1963.

Order

Robert D. Horn vs. Edgar Engle. On motion of plaintiff, case dismissed with prejudice and without costs.
