TOKYO (UPI)—A team of Oregon high school wrestling champions today overwhelmed a picked squad of trappers from Southern Kanto (Eastern Japan) high schools, scoring seven wins and a draw out of eight bouts.

It was the Oregon Huskies' eighth straight triumph by one-sided scores after they fought to a 4-4 draw at this same auditorium in their debut, July 15, against a picked Kanto team.
