Central Douglas UF Campaign Opens Sept. 9; Drive Goal Set

The Central Douglas United Fund campaign for 1963-64 officially gets under way Monday, Sept. 9. The kickoff breakfast is scheduled at 7 a.m. at the Roseburg Elks Temple. Guest speaker will be Glenn Jackson, vice president of Pacific Power & Light Co. and state Highway commissioner from Medford.

The goal for this year's campaign will be \$69,936. Last year, it was \$68,550.

Campaign Chairman Hazel Saxton today said she had appointed five of the 12 division chairmen. They are Ken Salmonson, business; Bob Feldkamp, advanced gifts; Norman Thurnhofer, outlying areas; Henry Flury, loggers' division; and Frank Riley, public employes.

The Central Douglas United Fund area extends from Oakland south to Dillard and takes in much of Central Douglas County.

Funds raised from the campaign support a group of county agencies,

such as the Red Cross, Boy Scouts of America, YMCA, retarded children and others. A small portion of the funds go to the Oregon United Appeal to support state agencies to which county people in need may turn. These include such agencies as the Villa St. Rose school for girls in Portland, Albertina Kerr Home for children and Vol-unteers of America Mothers and Childrens Home.
