Fortune Offered As Fair Finale

A specially-built chair has been built to hold the person whose ticket has the right number called during the final grandstand show Sunday night. It will be set on a scales and nickels will go on the other side of the scales until the balance is reached. If the person winning happens to weigh 300 pounds, he will collect \$1,400 worth of nickels.

No consideration is involved in the selections. A person need not buy a ticket to get a number. The number selected will be announced both inside and outside the Fairgrounds.

The announcement of number and weigh-in will be part of the grandstand program which starts at 9 p.m. Sunday.

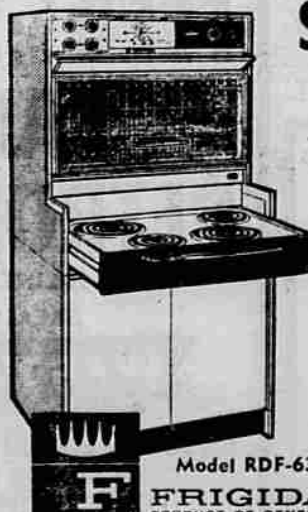
