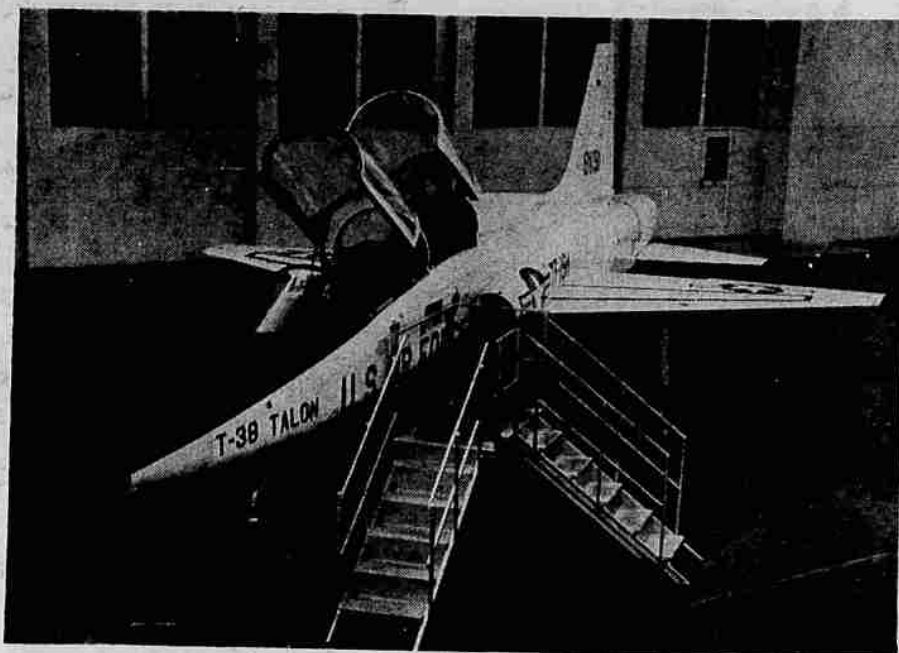




HIGH FLIER — This Air Force T-38 Talon is the world's first supersonic jet trainer. It will be on display near the main gate at the Douglas County Fair. Members of the orientation group from Norton Air Force Base will be on duty to answer questions. The plane reaches speeds over 840 miles-per-hour and climbs at 30,000 feet-per-minute. It flies at altitudes over 55,000 feet.

Commercial Exhibits Slated

A bumper crop of spectacular exhibits have been entered in this year's Douglas County Fair.

The "space needle" which became a landmark at the fair last year will give radio announcers a bird's eye view of activities as broadcasts are made from it.
