Beauty Grows In The Garden

Every year, the garden area of the Douglas County Fair becomes more beautiful.

In keeping with the "Moods of Magic" theme, it has reached a new high of beauty and restfulness this year. Winding through the well-landscaped area is a 400-foot-long stream. The source of water for the man-made stream is a waterfall which serves as the focal point. It pours some 300 gallons of water a minute into the stream. At the same time, it will form a backdrop for two fashion shows on the schedule. Round platforms in front of the seven-foot waterfall will allow models to show clothes in the best possible setting, with a five-foot sheet of water falling behind them.

The style shows will take place Thursday and Saturday nights at 7:30 p.m.

The beautiful garden area will be the setting also for garden plots prepared by Douglas County garden clubs on a "magic gardens" theme. It is expected at least a dozen clubs will have such plots.

The Douglas County Fair parking lot has parking facilities for 2,000 cars adjacent to the Fairgrounds.
