In the Ceramics Department, Wilma Wyatt of Roseburg, assisted by Camp Fire Girls, will show how ceramics objects are made.

of talented Roseburg bakers, give some pointers on cake decorating.

Three half-hour demonstrations are planned each day in cake decorating. Free samples of 150 decorated cupcakes will be distributed to ladies on Friday and Saturday.

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Hand Balancer Defies Danger

Combining his talents with Mandrake the Magician each night on a specially built stage in front of the grandstand at the Douglas County Fair will be The Great Montyne.

His stock in trade is hand balancing, made dangerous in almost every way he can devise. He contends that the element of danger is a basic ingredient in the art of the theater. He says, "Just as a splash of red color on a blank page creates an exciting contrast, so the introduction of danger into an entertainment program gives it an accent attainable in no other way."

With this philosophy, Montyne has gone out of his way to put it into practice.

Probably his most spectacularly

daring stunt is called "Climb of Death." It is accomplished over a bed of 38 upturned, razor-sharp steel blades. The only shield between him and the viciously shining blades is his balancing skill. This skill includes some of the most difficult one-arm balancing known to man.

This danger and skill is spiced with beauty, however. He is assisted by his beautiful wife, Madeline Sidney. Exquisitely costumed and graceful, she works in coordinated contrast to the dominating elements of danger and suspense.

In addition, she takes part in the balancing routine. She is literally suspended on the palm of his hand as he balances on a rolling cylinder.
