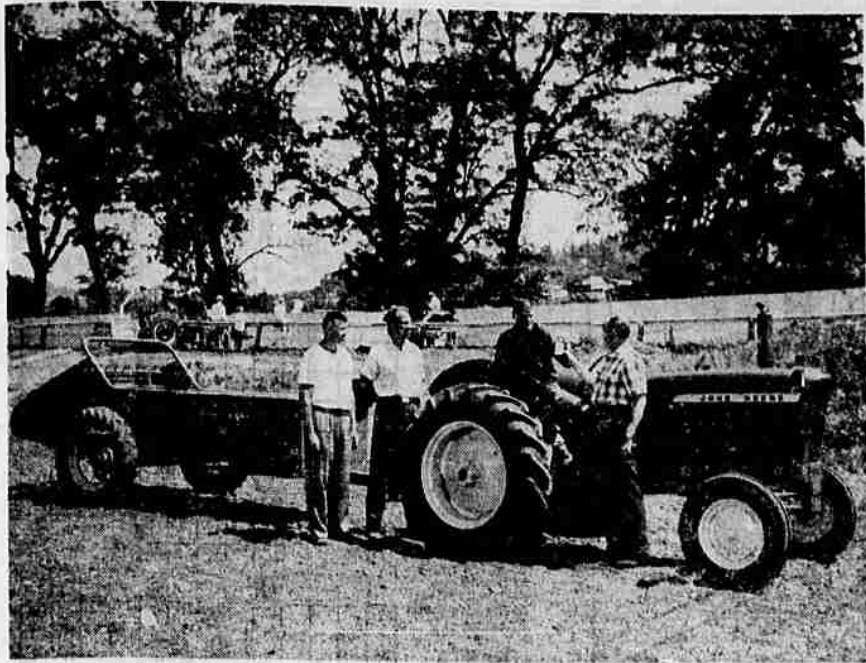

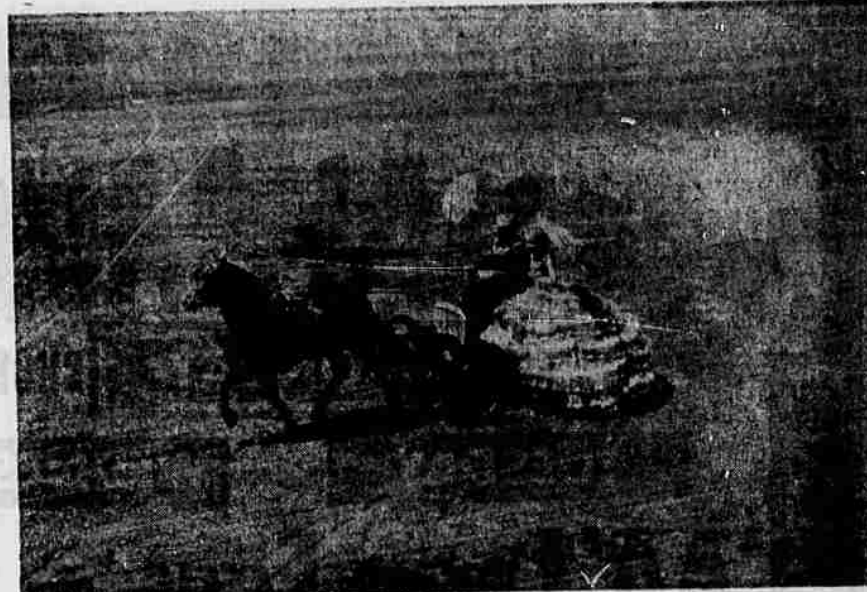
SOUND SUGGESTION

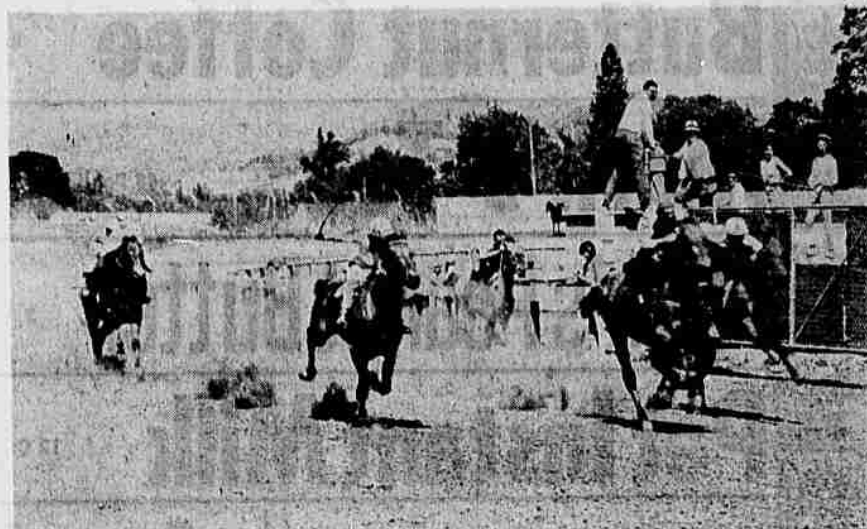
