He decided that it would be just too hard to make the hand against a 4-1 trump split, but that he would have no trouble against a 3-2 split, provided all the clubs weren't bunched in the East hand, and that West did not hold four to the jack.
After this decision play went quickly. South came to his hand with a club, ruffed a second spade in dummy, cashed dummy's king of trumps, overtook the queen with his ace, pulled East's last trump with his ten-spot, and led a club to dummy's king. West showed out and South was able to finesse against East's jack.
