W. N. Hackleman, resident engineer for the State Highway Department, spoke to Canyonville Lions about the tentative plans for four-laning the highway south of Canyonville, at the last regular dinner meeting of the group of The Foresters.

Mrs. R. E. Proctor, correspondent, reports that Hackleman said his office is mainly concerned with the first three of 18 miles now in the process of being surveyed. Plans are that bids will be let in the spring for construction and construction itself, which will involve several crews. The work will probably begin in the fall of 1964 and continue from there to five years, he said.
