It occurred to us however that we could bring you some helpful information about open lanes for non-league bowling. Presently at least in our area there are always open lanes available.

At the Four Winds Bowl—Lanes available every afternoon — except Sunday. Four of five open lanes every evening. Saturday and Sunday—All lanes open except Sunday afternoon.

At Indian Lanes—Lanes available every afternoon—except Thursday. Lanes available after 9:15 every evening — except Thursday.

Saturday and Sunday — All lanes open except Sunday afternoon.

At Roseburg Bowl—Lanes available every afternoon.

Lanes available after 9:15 every evening.

Six lanes open all Monday evening.

At least twelve open lanes Friday evening.

Saturday and Sunday — All lanes open.

It is not necessary to remember this schedule just telephone the Lanes and you will surely find an opening. Go out and roll that game you've wanted to bowl for such a long time.
