CIRCUIT COURT

Complaints

Marie E. Knight vs. Francis Hubert Conley. Plaintiff demands judgment against defendant for \$27,500 general damages and \$2,870 special damages for injuries allegedly suffered Nov. 8, 1962, at 9:45 p.m. in an accident involving the automobiles operated by the parties two miles south of Suburban on Interstate Highway 5. The plaintiff's car was struck from the rear, according to the complaint. She claims some of her injuries were of a permanent nature. Investment Service Co. vs. Virgil H. Harris, Sharon K. Harris, Marion Estrick and John Doe. Plaintiff asks judgment for recovery of a 1957 automobile sold to the Harris March 9, 1963, or \$550, plus attorney fees, as payment.

General Electric Supply Co., a division of General Electric Co., vs. Mervin and Vera F. Govey, copartners dba Ridge-way Appliance Co. Plaintiff demands judgment for \$87.90 alleged owing and due for goods, wares and merchandise.

Frank and Ella Mae Cumiskey vs. N. Dale and Valletta B. Wagoner. Plaintiff asks for decree that defendants pay full sum of \$3,617.11, plus interest and attorney fees or that land sales contract be foreclosed against property in city of Ridgeville.

Carl Young vs. State Industrial Accident Commission. Plaintiff asks case reopened and award of further medical aid, treatment and surgery as is necessary; award of temporary total disability from May 21, 1963, less time worked, and after treatment unless his condition improves substantially that he be granted permanent partial disability equivalent to 65 per cent loss function of an arm for unscheduled injuries to his back and spine. Plaintiff injured Feb. 15, 1963, while employed by Paul B. Hult Lumber Co., Dillard. He claims he was wrenched his back in attempting to move a 50 gallon drum of oil.

Dismissal

Paul Schulze, et al, vs. Herbert H. Brown, et al. Dismissed on motion of plaintiffs.

Mary Kissinger vs. Atlanta Isabell Hubbell. On stipulation of the parties case dismissed as settled with prejudice and without costs.

Marilyn Duncan, guardian of the estate and person of Patricia Ann West, vs. Standard Insurance Co. On motion of plaintiff, case dismissed with prejudice and without costs as settled.

OWG Supporting Retail Sales Tax

PORTLAND (UPI) — Oregon Wool Growers ended their annual convention here Tuesday with a resolution supporting a state retail sales tax to offset property and income taxes.

The wool growers also recommended that Oregon State University establish an IBM system to evaluate records of purebred sheep producers.

The shepherds urged continuing vigilance against imports of sheep from Canada, suggested more research on methods of controlling scrapie, a sheep disease, and sought restoration of \$7,200 for control of predators in the state by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

George Rugs, Heppner, was re-elected president of the group. Other officers were Gaylord Madison, Echo, first vice-president, Harold Williams, Bonanza, second vice-president and Jack Steiwer, Fossil, re-elected secretary.

Wieprecht To Attend Regional Park Meet
