

Howards Appears In 'Laughmaker'

Gordon Howard, formerly of Roseburg, will appear in the world premiere of "The Laughmaker," a Lawrence and Lee play, at the University of Minnesota.

Howard is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Clifford Howard of Rt. 4, Roseburg.

A graduate of the University of Oregon where he received B.S. and M.S. degrees, Howard is presently involved in graduate study in theater as a McKnight Fellow at the University of Minnesota and the Guthrie Theatre. This coming spring he will join the acting company at the Guthrie.

"The Laughmaker" centers on an intimate theater in Paris at the turn of the century and concerns the happiness and tragedy in the lives of two great comedians. Howard is featured in the part of "Goret."

Howard achieved collegiate attention in dramatics at the University of Oregon where he appeared in several productions. His career in drama has included legitimate theater experience on Broadway. Howard's venture into Broadway acting was underwritten by a loan from this community, which he subsequently repaid.

Museum Group Hosts Expert At Reception

W. G. Archer, O.B.E., Keeper Emeritus of the Indian Section of the Victoria and Albert Museum, London, will be honored at a reception in the Museum of Art at the University of Oregon Monday, Nov. 11.

The reception, given by the Friends of the Museum, will be at 9 p.m., following an illustrated lecture by Archer.

Archer, distinguished British authority on Oriental art, will lecture on "The Loves of Krishna," at 8 p.m. in 150 Science. The address is under the auspices of the University's School of Architecture and Allied Arts.

Two exhibitions, especially featuring the occasion, will be shown in the Museum's galleries in conjunction with Archer's appearance. These exhibitions, sponsored by the Friends of the Museum, will be "Persian and Indian Miniatures from the Collection of Edwin Binney, 3rd, Portland Art Museum," and "Contemporary Iranian Paintings," (circulated by the Western Association of Art Museums).

The two exhibitions, with an exhibition of the Metal Arts Guild: 1962, will be on display through Nov. 24.

Hatfield To Appear At Opening Session

SALEM (UPI)—Gov. Mark Hatfield will appear before the joint session of the legislature Monday afternoon to recommend solutions to the state's fiscal crisis.

The governor will address the joint session in the House chambers shortly after the special session is convened at noon.

He will recommend that lawmakers open basic school support to allotment control, and ask for re-enactment of the one-shot speedup of withholding tax collections.

Travis Cross, Hatfield's press secretary, said the governor's address would be about 15 minutes in length.
