Both families are prominent pioneer residents of this county. The Singletons were married Oct. 31, 1893, and after the wedding reception went to their newly built home on SE Douglas Ave., where they have continued to make their residence during their 70 years of marriage.

Mr. Singleton, a prominent building contractor, has built some of Roseburg's most beautiful homes. Although he will be 91 years of age in January, he still does considerable building, raises a fine garden annually and never fails to go hunting. This fall found him climbing Oregon's highest mountain on a deer hunting trip and the day before the season closed, he shot a large buck deer (without the aid of glasses or a gunscope).

Mrs. Singleton, who was 91 Saturday, is one of Roseburg's best housekeepers and homemakers. She has done much sewing and handwork during her life time and has made numerous hand-made quilts, crocheted table cloths and many outstandingly lovely embroidered linens. She is an excellent cook and a most gracious hostess. The large number of friends calling to congratulate them on their 70th anniversary was a testament to their many years of friendship.
