# Experts Are Not In Agreement On Effect Of Tax Cut Measure

WASHINGTON (UPI)—It all depends on what witness is testifying to know what the \$11 billion tax cut bill passed by the House means to your pocket-book.

The Treasury supplied official figures supporting the bill which showed that taxpayers with income of \$3,000 to \$5,000 a year would pay 38.3 per cent less taxes, or \$555 million less.

Perhaps Mark M. Jones, president of the National Economic Council of New York, supplied the last word. He indicated the entire argument over how many dollars this or that person would get might be futile.
