Senators Ask Open Hearing On Standards

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Senators from half a dozen wheat-growing states recently called for public Senate hearings on the Agriculture Department's proposal to tighten federal grade standards for wheat.

Senate Majority Leader Mike Mansfield, Mont., and Assistant Democratic Leader Hubert H. Humphrey, Minn., were among the 11 Democrats and Republicans joining in the request to hold hearings.

"Few issues have caused greater concern in our states this year," the senators said in a letter to Ellender.

They said the proposal to tighten up wheat standards, reducing tolerances for "dockage" and other defects in the present federal grades, is "vigorously opposed by the National Federation of Grain Cooperatives and certain segments of the private grain trade as an unnecessary... new handling expense."

The federation, the legislators said, contends the change would result in lower returns to farmers. As an alternative, the federation has proposed adoption of special grade standards for use only on export wheat.

Backers of the proposed changes assert that stricter grade standards are needed to protect and enlarge export markets for American wheat.

The wheat state legislators said Senate hearings should be held before Agriculture Secretary Orville L. Freeman issues a final decision on the proposed grade changes. Mid-December was proposed as a convenient target for opening Senate hearings.

Sen. Pearson Says He Favors Doing Away Entirely With Basic School Support Fund

The Douglas County Livestockport fund, in addition, he said, "with no strings attached," instead of an offset, don't have to compete with a sales tax.
