WHITMAN U OPENS BALL SEASON HERE APRIL 12

Pre-Season Prospects Are Better Than for Several Years

With the exception of Willamette, all the proposed baseball dates have been confirmed by the respective managers, and the season will open at Eugene with Whitman April 12th and 13th.

Oregon's squad is fast rounding into form, and although the team has not been picked as yet, the bunch has narrowed down to about 18 men. Taylor and Word will attend to the receiving. Houck, Peet and Cozens constitute the pitching staff, and it seems to have first cinched, although he has warmed up his arm for nothing in case a south-paw is need on the trip. Fenton will cover first in Janie's absence, and with Newland and Dobbie, Peet is fighting it out for second. "Cady" Roberts seems to be the logical man for the difficult corner. The outfield has eight aspirants, VanMarter, Chandler, Moun, Barbour, Stewart, Fisher and "Walt" Dobbie, and the selection will depend mainly upon the ability to wield the bat.

The team will start Friday, April 14, on the trip north, playing Multnomah on the 15th, U. of W., at Seattle, on the 17th and 18th, W. S. C., at Pullman, on the 19th and 20th, Idaho at Moscow on the 21st and 22nd. W. S. C. has been unfortunate this season, their first baseman having broken his leg in a practice game.

Manager Luckey has supplied one man in each of the various frats and clubs with a bunch of season tickets, and those outside will be canvassed by Ferguson, Ferruset and Cass.

23 SCHOOLS SIGNED UP

Interscholastic Meet Promises to be Best in History of Prep Meets

With twenty-three prep schools already signed up, and negotiations on with several others, the interscholastic track meet, dated for May 12, will exceed in entries and events any previous state meet.

The high and prep schools entered to date are as follows: Washington, Lincoln, Jefferson, Allen Preparatory, of Portland; Columbia University, Vancouver, Eugene, Baker, Pendleton, Enterprise, The Dalles, Medford, Oregon City, Newberg, Prineville, Hood River, Roseburg, Oakland, Grants Pass, La Grande, Cottage Grove, Junction and Springfield.

The larger schools are sending six men, the smaller four. All told, at least 125 men are expected to enter.

The track is being widened and a new lot of hurdles is under construction, which will lessen considerably the number of preliminaries necessary.

The medals for the event have arrived from the East, and are pronounced a fine lot by those who have examined them.

Fraternities who are contributing toward medals, or are offering special medals, are asked to see Joan Kestly and settle for the same.

The committee on entertainment will meet this week and assign men to the different houses.
