PRESIDENT CAMPBELL ADDRESSES ASSEMBLY

Delivers Able Exposition of Life of Greatest Russian Writer,

Tolstoi

This morning's assembly address was given by President Campbell, who spoke on Tolstoi.

In opening his address, he stated that he approached the subject from the layman's point of view, dealing mainly with the effects of the life and writings of the great Russian upon present day society. Several movements which are attracting much attention can be traced, in part, he asserted, directly to the influence of Tolstoi. Prominent among these are the idea of the obligation of personal wealth for social service, the simple life movement, and the movement toward a more simple Christianity.

In outlining the life of Tolstoi, he divided it into three approximate periods. The first, to the conclusion of his university career at the age of 23. The second, a space of about thirty years in which he played the part of soldier, writer, and man of the world. About fifteen of his books were produced in this period. The third period covers the last thirty years of the writer's life. During kind or flavor. . . . Call this time he was author, social reformer, and philosopher. About the some number of books were produced in this period as in the second.

The speaker then brought the story of Tolstoi's life up to the point where he became despondent over the problem of life, and told how he finally solved for himself that momentous question by observing the happy lives of the peasants and determining to model his life after them.

In measuring up the teaching of the great novelist, President Campbell said that the great thing which we get out of it is that there is something worth while. We need not go as far as he and accept his solution, but that solution is at least interest-

Before the address, the audience was favored with a musical selection by Miss Mary DeBar, Mrs. Stackpole and Mr. Marion.
