SENIOR WORKS THESIS OF PRACTICAL VALUE

Roy Fitch, a senior in the Chemistry Department, has been working from thirty to forty hours a week since last December gathering data for his thesis on "A Method for the Qualitative and Quantitative Determination of Hypochlorites in Dilute Aqueous Solutions." Hypochlorites are mineral salts used in purification of drinking water, and all of the experiments and tests regarding them have been made on the Eugene city

The purpose of Fitch's long experimental work has been to establish the fact that none of this hypochlorite added to the water produced free chlorine, which is an offensive element in water. He is also trying to discover and perfect a method of determining the amount of hypochlorite escaping into the water. The results will be announced later.


