**MEDICAL SCHOOL NOW  
HOLDS CLASS A RANK**

FULL COLLEGE YEAR REQUIRED  
FOR ENTRANCE

Six Professors Now Hold Chairs—  
Several New Appliances  
Installed.

Through the fact that the Medical Department of the University of Oregon has made extensive improvements, both in equipment and entrance requirements, it has recently been placed in the Class "A" division by The American Medical Institute.

The entrance requirements have been raised so that a full college year is now required of all prospective students, and it is the intention of the faculty to still further raise the requirements during the next two years.

At the same time, two regular professors have been added, which makes a total of six regular professors besides the corps of lecturers. This places the department on a level with all Class "A" institutions in the country.

Equipment has been improved, buildings have been remodeled and refurnished, and the laboratories replenished with apparatus.

Great interest is being manifested in football at Pullman, even the professors are out regularly watching Johnnie Bender perfect his 1912 machine.
