MINISTERS OVER STATE CAN SEND FOR BOOKS WANTED

PARCEL

POST UTILIZED

Taking Advantage of Chance, Are Payment of Postage and Return Within Month.

The University Library in conjunction with the United States parcel post system, is planning an invasion of the State in order that its admore generally throughout Oregon. a circular letter to all Oregon minissending copies of the lists of books which are added weekly to the library. The following is an excerpt from the letter:

"At a conference of ministers held at the University last summer, the request was made that the University library be made available for the use of the ministers of the State. In response to that request, we are pleased to say that boks that can be spared will be sent out on the following conditions:

"(1) Transportation charges both ways are to be met by the ministers borrowing the books.

"(2) Books are to be returned within a month after they are sent out and are subject to recall if needed sooner by the University."

No special limit will be placed upon the number of books which may be drawn out at a time.

The lists of the weekly additions are sent in order to indicate the scope of the library. Among the subjects included are: Political and social sciences, education, natural history, chemistry, useful arts, literature, description and travel, philosphy and psychology history, etc. Ministers who may be interested, are invited to write the library for information regarding particular topics of interest.

Sororities at Whitman College Unite

Sororities at Whitman college, Walla Walla, have adopted new rules in regard to pledging, which to away with much of the excitement coincident with pledge days. Following is the rule:

"Uniform invitations, consisting of the words, 'The ty invites you to become one of its ROACH'S MUSIC STORE members,' and a list of active members will be sent out through the dean of women on Saturday noon. (Date to be designated later.) Written acceptances and regrets, both in case of more than one invitation, must be handed in on the following Monday at or before 7 o'clock."

During this time, from Saturday aoon until 8 o'clock, absolutely no communication, written or otherwise, will be allowed between Freshmen and Sorority women. This restriction applies not only to those sorority members now in college, but to ex-members, alumnae, and patronesses of the Sorority.

In case of Freshmen rooming with a member of a Sorority, arrangements shall previously be made whereby they shall be separated during the stated time.-Idaho Argo-
