MARSHALL SELLS OREGON
FICTION WRITER PRODUCING 5000 WORDS DAILY
Stories Treat of Animal Life in John Day Valley, Klamath County and Blue Mountains
"Medford Man is Selling Oregon to Entire Nation," is the headline on a column story written by Lawrence Dinneen, former Oregon student, who visited the southern town and ran into Edison Marshall, also an Oregon product, who has been doing so well in short story writing since 1915 that he is now producing 5000 words daily and has no trouble in finding a market for them. These men were fellow students at the University a few years back. Dinneen, who is now in the circulation department of the Journal, in writing of Marshall, says: "He has been making 'so good' in short stories since I last saw him in 1915 that I wanted to have a chat. I grabbed him, waited until he bought 85c worth of October magazines containing his stories, and then I steered him away from a pretty girl in front of a big automobile and took him to a secluded corner of a lounging room in the Medford University club. There I had him tell me of himself for the past four and a half years. I went further and had him tell me of his life from the time he was born at Rensselaer, Ind., August 28, 1894. "Marshall has sold a lot of his 'stuff' is selling it and hence is sure of himself. Right now he's writing 5000 words a day on Oregon subject matter, mostly stories of animals of the entire state. "One story may be based on Marshall's home territory in the hills and valleys of southern Oregon, another tells of the sage hens of the John Day, another of the lakes of Klamath and Lake counties, another of the Blue mountains. Marshall is selling Oregon at the rate of 5000 words a day. "I asked him what magazines he sold to and he answered, "It would be easier to tell you what magazines I do not sell to."
