2 Days Allowed to Get Cards In Rules governing the registration of the winter term are similar to
those governing the fall term with those governing the fall term with
very few exceptions. The first day
of the term is registration and all study cards must be filled out and filed not later than two days after
registration. Otherwise a late regisregistration. Otherwise a late regis-
tration fee of $\$ 1.00$ will be charged
and also 50 cents in addition will be colfected for each additional day's delay. For example, for those not
registering until Thursday, January 8, a late registration fee will be
charged, for those registering Friday charged, for those registering Friday
