

# GIRLS TO INCREASE ATHLETIC ACTIVITY

Association Plans Expansion of Work at Meeting.

LEADERS ALL CHEERFUL

Favorable Reports Given On Different Sports.

Plans for work in their new home, the women's building, were discussed at the second meeting of the Women's Athletic Association in Professor Howes' room yesterday afternoon at 4:15. In addition to up to date athletic equipment, the association will have special rooms for its meetings and a bulletin board in the main hall for its exclusive use.

The reports given by the heads of sports all promised great achievements in the new building. Charlotte Howells, head of basketball, has nine teams promised for doughnut basketball, and it going to see that some trophy is presented the winning team. From the doughnut teams, class teams will be chosen and possibly a varsity team. A game with the Oregon Agricultural College will be arranged if possible.

**Practice Hours Set.**  
Practice hours in the new gymnasium will be 3 and 4 o'clock Tuesdays and Thursdays; 4 o'clock Wednesdays and Fridays in the indoor gymnasium and 5 o'clock every day on both floors. This will furnish ample time for all interested to practice and Miss Howells urges that the different women's organizations enter into the competition.

Frances Moore, head of swimming, and Emily Perry, head of track, gave brief reports on the work planned for next term. If possible, the indoor track meet will be held separately from the regular public exhibition of gymnasium work given annually each spring and an outdoor meet will be arranged for.

**Varsity Sweaters Wanted.**  
Emily Perry, chairman, Winifred Hopson and Lois Barnett were appointed a committee to propose to the student body a change in the constitution which will provide sweaters for members of the varsity baseball teams. The student body presents sweaters for hockey, swimming, tennis and basketball. Baseball is growing in importance yearly, however, and last year the girl's team defeated the Oregon Agricultural College. A hotly contested doughnut series was also played and the Association feels that the sport is becoming important enough to justify the recognition by the student body.

Ruth Austin was appointed chairman to choose her own committee for the selection of the association's gift to the women's building.
