

OREGON SWIMMERS WILL ENTER MEET

George Neale and 'Hap' Hazard to Compete.

Two entries in the State Swimming and Diving championship meet will be made by the University of Oregon. The meet is scheduled for this coming Saturday and is to be held in the Multnomah Amateur Athletic Club tank in Portland. The meet is being sponsored by the Multnomah Club, who, according to the dope, are to make strong bids for the heavy pieces in the majority of the events.

George Neale and "Hap" Hazard will represent the lemon-yellow in the aquatic contest. Neale will swim in the 100 yard free-for-all and Hazard will enter the 50 yard swim.

Oregon will not be represented in any of the other events. A number of the school's best swimmers, who have carried off laurels in meets throughout the country, are unable to participate.

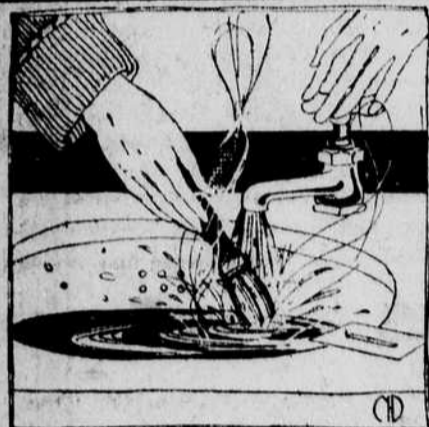
"Micky" Ringler Out.
"Micky" Ringler, who was scheduled to enter in the 150 yard backhand swim, will be unable to attend on account of recent injuries to his eye. Conflicting student activities prevent "Micky" Wilsey and "Bus" Douglas from making the trip. Both Douglas and Wilsey are members of the freshman basketball squad and due to the games which are scheduled with the O. A. C. rooks this week-end, will be unable to enter in the swims.

Reports from Portland state that the Multnomah club is prepared to make a strong bid for the state championships. They are said to have developed a number of good men, though are handicapped by the loss of such men as Douglas who formerly starred for the winged M. Williams, who is entered in the 50 yard swim for Multnomah is reported to be making the distance in 26 seconds with ease. Hazard, who is to compete in this race for Oregon placed in the meets at Pasadena a few years ago and was the only man on the lemon-yellow squad to place in the dual meet held with the Multnomah club here last junior week-end.

Neale State Champion.
Neale, who is to compete in the 100 yard free-for-all hails from San Diego, Cal. He was captain of the California state interscholastic swimming team in 1919 and was also a member of the San Diego Rowing club relay team.

Saturday's meet is to be staged in the nature of a preliminary to the big meet which will embrace coast competition, which is to be held later in the year.

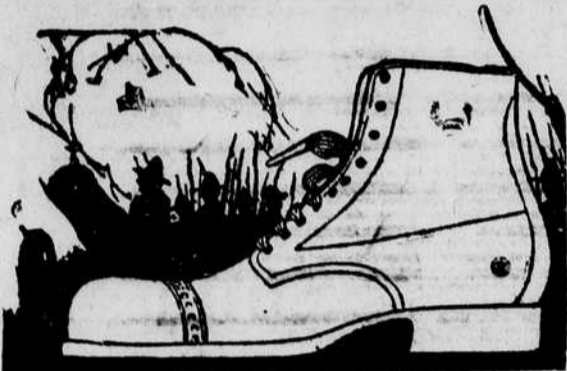
