

**CAMPBELL WILL SPEAK AT PENDLETON MEETING**

Endowment Campaign Only in Early Stage of Organization; President Studied Eastern Methods

One of the features of the alumni-former students meeting that will be held at the Elks' club in Pendleton next Wednesday night will be the presence of President P. L. Campbell, who has spent the past month in the East, studying the methods of procedure of the leading colleges there, where endowment funds have been raised. President Campbell was due in Eugene from his eastern trip yesterday, but failed to arrive.

Up to the present time, the endowment campaign has been one of organization. The chief objective so far has been the organization of alumni and former students into groups actively interested in the welfare of the University. An intensive educational campaign has also been waged during the autumn and early winter months, to familiarize the people of Oregon with the work and the needs of Oregon.

"The people of Oregon do not understand what the University needs and what it is doing," said Professor Ralph D. Casey, of the school of journalism, "if they can be made to understand, they will be more interested."

To this end alumni organizations have been formed in eleven counties of Oregon. Before the close of the year, it is hoped that such an organization will exist in every county. Within the next week, meetings will be held in Pendleton, Baker and La Grande.

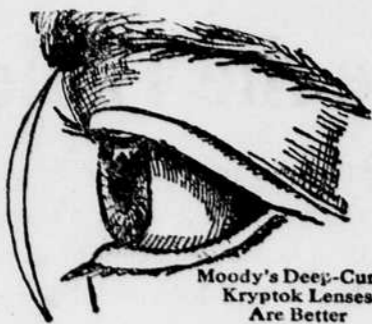
