Nor is the Egyptian premier, Zagloul Pasha, unfamiliar with Great Britain. He has been a lawyer, an ardent champion of the unconditional independence of his country, whose activities have caused him to be twice expelled by the British. He has spent some time in British captivity both at Malta and Gibraltar, He is reported to have profited from these periods of enforced leisure by perfeeting himself in the English language.


