

Campus Movie Scenario Begun Under L. Lewis

Godfrey Makes Additions To Advisory Staff; Help From Portland Accepted

Work on preparation of a scenario for the University of Oregon moving picture production started this week under the direction of Leslie L. Lewis, instructor in English.

Myron Griffin, head of the student committee, has appointed Henry Lumpke, Jean Patrick and Alex Tamkin to assist him in working on the script which is to be ready within two weeks.

Several persons interested in the production have been added to the advisory staff by George H. Godfrey, faculty chairman. These will assist with suggestions and criticism of the student work.

The university picture staff has also voted to work with the cooperation of the Portland Cine club, of which Mr. LeFevre is president.

Interest in the production is already campus-wide, and much interest is also noted throughout the state. It is planned to show the film first on the campus, then in Portland under the auspices of the Cine club, and then in any part of the state where people desire to see it.
