

# Sigma Kappa Heads House Grade Lists

### First Group Averages 54.070 Points

### Kappa Delta Places Next; Friendly Hall Third To Lead Men

With an average of 54.070 points Sigma Kappa, national sorority, headed the house grade list, just released by the registrar's office. Kappa Delta, with 53.211, was second among women's organizations and also second on the campus.

Friendly hall, with an average of 52.847, was close behind the two leaders to take first place among men's organizations and third place among all groups. Omega hall, second among the men's organizations, with 49.000, stood in twelfth place among the 50 organizations.

Another of Warner Oland's great characterizations as the crafty Chinese detective, Charley Chan, is being shown at the State for today only in "Charley Chan Carries On."




