the same parents should be equally pleased to continue the contribution while the son or daughter has the added advantage of a normal emotional life and the incentives of marriage; and the child should have no hesitation in accepting it.

"If one or both should have financial obligations, it makes these

obligations none the lighter that in addition they should be deprived the normal life of the marriage partnership. And "t.c.l.a.c.a."; marriage if carefully planned need not add to the difficulty of meeting rightful obligations.

Marry and Travel

"Early marriage should not generally interfere with the variety of experience in travel, sports, personal acquaintance, reading, cultural recreations, etc., which is regarded as the privilege of youth. All these things can be the more satisfying when the couple take

them mainly together. Your plan to develop a social life especially adapted to married couples is important.

"If two young people are thinking of marrying and look to members of your organization to guide them, they can well be advised that performance in university classes, sports, and parties is not an adequate basis for selection. Before deciding on marriage they should have been acquainted long enough to see each other under trying circumstances; and should have learned about each other's

families; health histories; attitudes toward vocation; beliefs and main interests in religion, philosophy, politics, and philanthropy; tastes in art and recreation; and wishes and standards in regard to children, to money, to housekeeping responsibilities, to mutual agree-

ment, and to the meaning of careers.
