Card Campaign Heralds Death Of ASUO Drives

State Board Ruling Makes Ticket Sale No Longer Needed

When Chairman Bob Keen and his associates promoting the present spring term ASUO card drive close shop at noon this coming Saturday and take home their portfolios, it will mark the bona fide death of such campaigns conducted on the Oregon campus.

Oregon's state board of higher education has decreed that in the future funds to finance events now being taken care of by ASUO-card sales will be collected in a registration fee at the beginning of the school year.

New Setup

After this, according to Activities Chairman George Root, the educational activities board will arrange probably for only an athletic card sale or a student body membership card ticket drive. The new state ruling puts the full ASUO-sponsored activity slate in the realm of a regular curricular function.



Representatives selling cards in all living groups will meet at the College Side at 4:30 this afternoon.

Events for which the \$3 spring term card is good include the "Spring Varieties," Jose Iturbi's performance, all freshman and varsity baseball games played on Howe field during the term, tennis and golf matches, University track meets, the Emerald, and student body elections.
