

Comish Slates Utah Teaching

Summer Session Instruction Plan Of BA Professor

Dr. Newell H. Comish, professor in the University of Oregon school of business administration, will teach as visiting professor during the 1940 summer sessions at the University of Utah, Salt Lake City, it was revealed yesterday.

Dr. Comish will leave the campus on June 10 with his family for the six weeks' session at Utah, where he will be one of three visiting professors in the school of business administration. He will teach two courses, survey methods of distribution and problems of distribution.

The position was acquired as a direct result of acclaim won by the research work, done by Dr. Comish and students in business administration, in comprehensive surveys of a number of Oregon stores.

Upon completion of the summer sessions, Dr. Comish will leave for a month's tour of the East. He plans to motor through the South and up the Atlantic coast to New York City, taking motion pictures and making studies of store moderations in many large department houses. If time permits he will journey into New England before returning to the Pacific coast. He plans to arrive back at Oregon on the first of September.

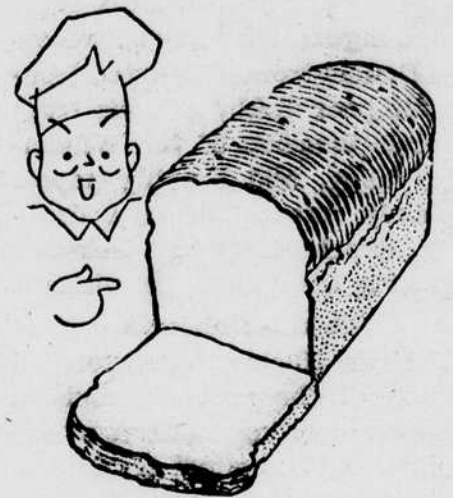

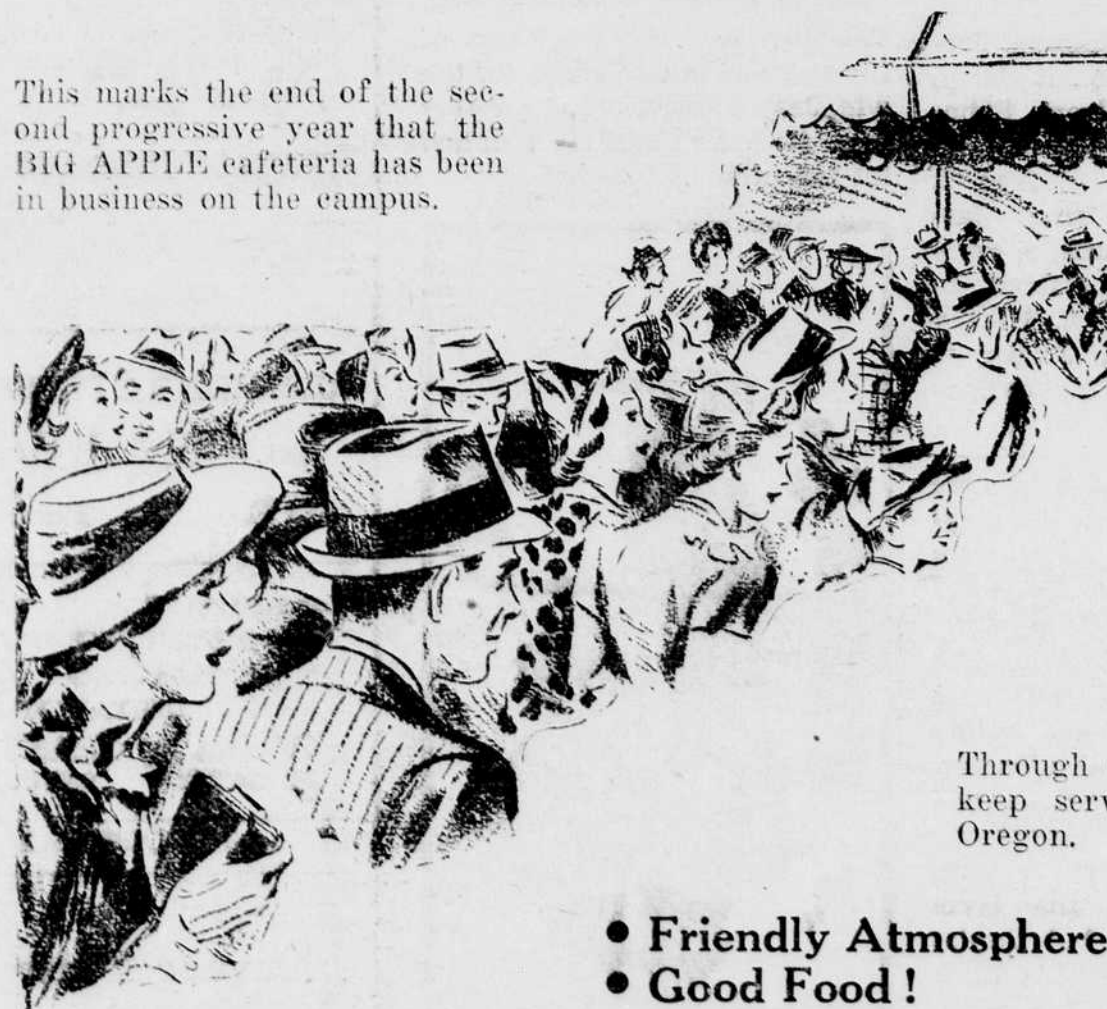
