This is the first time for a number of terms that a Greek house has led independent groups in GPAs.

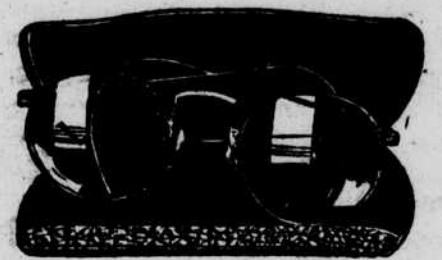
