

Grace Moore To Head List On Artist Series

More than 500 tickets have been sold thus far by the educational activities office for the five-star greater artist series concert season, activities officials said Wednesday.

First star to appear in the series, sponsored by the educational activities board, will be Grace Moore, widely-known soprano, who will come to Oregon October 10. This will be her first appearance at Oregon.

Miss Moore, golden of voice and golden of hair, has long been a favorite on the stage and screen. Her beauty, dramatic ability and personal magnetism, have earned for her the title "America's Queen of Song."

Faculty members who have made down payments on their season tickets, but have not yet paid the balance were urged to do so before October 1, by educational activities officials, because a tax of 10 per cent of the unpaid balance will have to be added after that date. This is in accordance with new government tax laws which go into effect on that date, they said.

Second attraction of the series will be Violinist Yehudi Menuhin, who comes to the campus December 1. Menuhin, because of his superb violin playing, is known as the "prodigy of yesterday, genius of today, immortal of tomorrow."

Menuhin will be followed January 7, 1942, by Josef Hofmann, pianist, who has been brought again to Oregon by popular demand.

The Seattle symphony orchestra, conducted by Sir Thomas Beecham, will appear here February 23 as part of his first professional tour of the United States.

Returning to Eugene after a successful program here a few years ago is Nino Martini, star of concert and opera, who will appear April 8, 1942. The handsome tenor will be the last of the group to appear here.

Oregon students are regularly admitted to these concerts on their educational activities cards. Season tickets are available to faculty members and townspeople.

(Continued from page one) they vote" to be members of a dues paying class, as they had been last year.

Within five days after their adoption of a constitution they will meet to select by-laws and nominate officers. "We hope to have the whole thing over with in two weeks," Torgeson said.

It was the frosh class last year that lit the powder keg of class cards, when, in their first meeting, a large bloc raised loud objections to a constitutional amendment proposed to the so-called "model constitution" that would make class cards compulsory for class membership.

After a fall term of bickering, this bloc broke away from the old organization to establish the "majority class of 1944," under freshman politician Chuck Woodruff.

Plans are being made this year, said Torgeson, to prevent any split in the 1945 group, which might make both factions weak and ineffectual.
