**Defense Effects  
 Due on Campus**

Effects of Fiorello LaGuardia's civilian defense program will soon begin to be felt on the campus, according to Dr. Donald M. Erb, University president and member of LaGuardia's commission for colleges and civilian defense.

A meeting of the University's committee on national defense was held in President Erb's office Thursday. At that time the president told other members of the committee what other colleges and universities in the East were doing in the way of defense and defense education. He also turned over to them, through their chairman, Dr. Howard Taylor, the pamphlets and other material he brought with him.

Some time next week another meeting will be held to determine "how far we want to go" on civilian defense. The committee will probably establish two or three voluntary, non-credit defense classes in such subjects as first-aid and fire aid precautions, said President Erb Friday.

He may make a speech to the assembled student body sometime during winter term on the topic and more definite action will be taken later, although not on the elaborate scale of some eastern institutions, he explained.
