

A Brown university expedition will travel to South America to attempt to photograph the zodiacal light of the sun during a total eclipse.




Architecture and allied arts students are evidently studying harder this year than they did in 1940-41, according to Mabel A. Houck, librarian of the architecture and allied arts school library.
