Many Webfoots Have High Posts Among United States Navy Corps

Following is the University of Oregon honor roll of service. It is undoubtedly incomplete, however, it is offered as a start in the Emerald effort to recognize Oregon's service men.

In conformity with military censorship regulations, anything which might be of military value to the enemy has been deleted from the list. Address do not contain the company or battalion of army men, nor the ship name in the cases of naval attachment. In some instances the forwarding address is given in place of the military.

The complete list was loaned to the Emerald through Old Oregon, alumni magazine, which printed the names of all these men in its latest issue. It was also members of the Old Oregon staff who collected these names through alumni files.

Although in the minority, the navy boasts a number of Oregon graduates who have attained high posts. Among these is Commander Ross T. McIntire, M.D., President Roosevelt's personal physician, a graduate of 1912. Of another, Harry Sweek Harding, M.D., class of 1916, the roll says, "was a lieutenant commander, medical corps, U. S. naval station, Guam, P.I."
