For sheer foolish froth—buy a bottle of apple blossom bubble bath and get a jump on nature as to fragrance.

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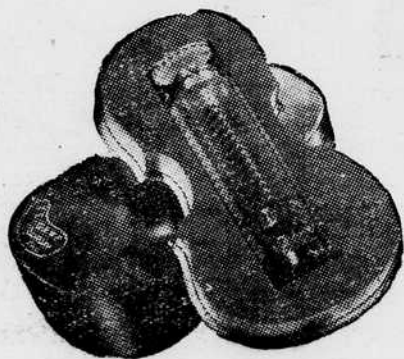


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
