

# Navy Reserve Plan Shown

(Continued from page one) for officers' training classes will be ordered to active duty as enlisted men, and "ear marked" for an officer training class in accordance with routine procedure.

At the completion of six months of active duty as an enlisted man the bureau of naval personnel will request his commanding officer to state whether the candidate has demonstrated sufficient aptitude, ability, and officer-like qualities to merit his being recommended for transfer to an officer, or petty officer training class. If favorable recommendation is received he will be transferred to such a school; if unfavorable he will be retained as an enlisted man until he may prove himself to be officer material.

### Class V-5

V-5 is designed to supply the navy with a steady flow of officer material for the air corps. Men are enlisted in this class and deferred until the end of the current college year.

Candidates for enlistment must be male citizens of the United States. They must have been naturalized for more than ten years except on recommendation of the senior member of the naval aviation cadet selection board. They must not be less than 18, nor more than 27 years of age at the time of their enlistment.

The period of active duty is four years, including the training period as aviation cadet, unless released sooner by the navy department.

Men must be unmarried, and agree to remain unmarried until completion of flight training and acceptance of commission as ensign, U.S. naval reserve.

for V-7 are similar to those of class V-1.

Training of seamen, class V-7, is given in two sections. The first is a preliminary period of thirty days in which they are given an insight into life aboard ship, and instructions in the fundamentals of military discipline, naval customs and usage.

If for any reason a cadet is not recommended for further training at the end of this period, he is discharged or if he so requests he is transferred to an enlisted status in another branch of the reserve for which he is qualified.

### Midshipman Class

At the completion of the initial course, successful candidates are transferred to the midshipman class and retained for three months further training.

Satisfactory completion of the prescribed course of instruction will qualify the reserve midshipman for a commission as ensign, U. S. naval reserve. Thereafter, promotion will be in accordance with the regulations governing promotion of officers of his class.

Eleven weekly programs are being broadcast over station WHA.

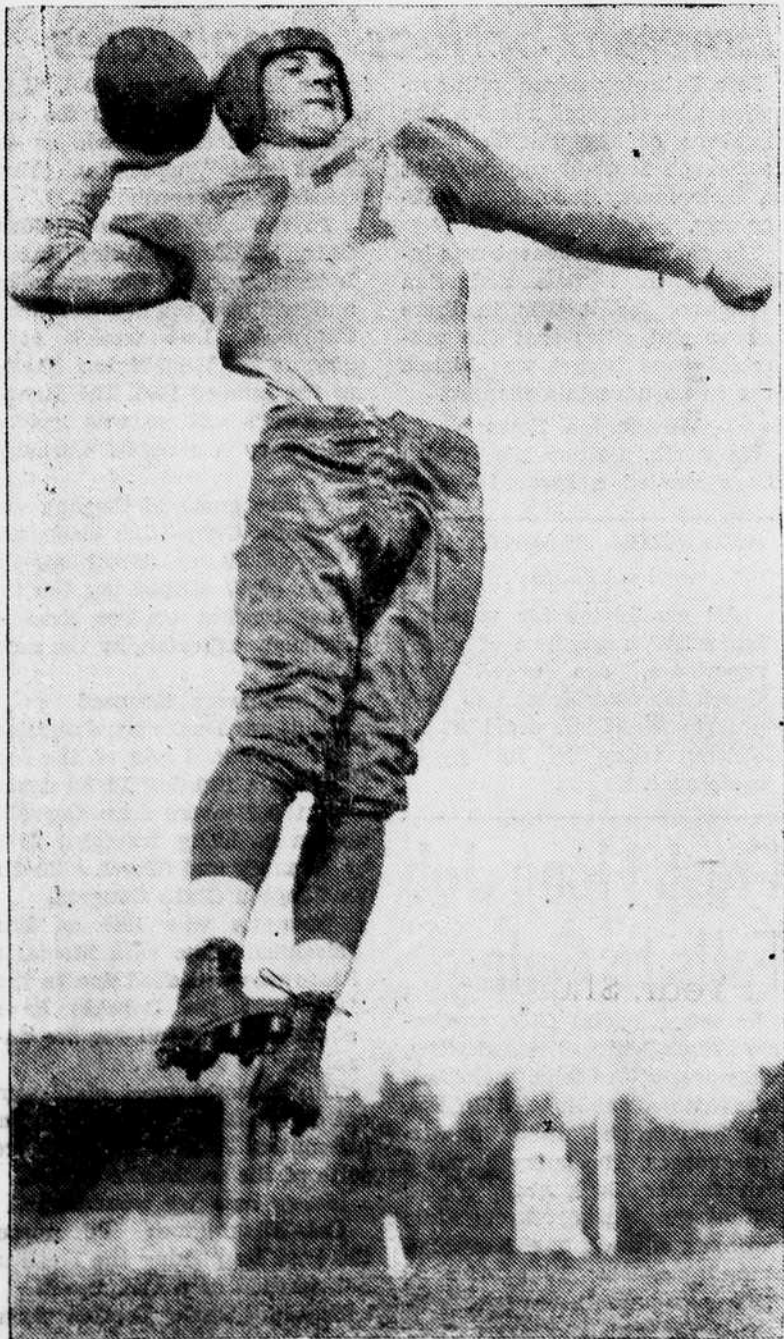
