Fourth place is still being cuddled by Joltin' Jim Jurkovich, Cal's now - you - see - him - now - you - don't half-back, with 39, to his credit.

Stanford lays claim to the last member of the big scoring five in the person of Ward Sheller, who has amassed 36 points in ten contests.
