Alpha Xi Delta Tops Victory Dinner Drive

Alpha Xi Delta won the fall term Victory Dinner drive, with Kappa Kappa Gamma and Delta Delta Delta as runners-up, according to reports from the treasurers of all civilian living organizations taking part in the drive.

On the percentage basis, the winners had \$1.64 per girl, with a total of \$25.95 taken in during the term by their house. The Kappas took in 98 cents per girl with a \$11.15 total for the term. The Tri-Deltas totaled \$29.30 with 62 cents per girl.

Approximately \$300 was collected during the term and 22 women's living organizations participated in the drive.

Headed by Mary Bentley, chairman of the defense stamp and bond drives, the Victory Dinners have been held once each week on Tuesday nights. The plan provides that each member of each house buy her way into dinner with a 10-cent defense stamp, with the aim of each house going 100 per cent every week.

The drive will be continued for the remainder of the school year with houses going 100 per cent announced each week and at the end of each term announcement will be made of the house which collected the most money per girl.
